## **Armenian memorial wins support for Greenway site**

More than 120 people attended a North End meeting Wednesday about the future of a half-acre near Christopher Columbus Park on the Rose Fitzgerald Kennedy Greenway. The crowd overwhelmingly supported a proposed gift from the Armenian Heritage Foundation for a park, designed with a labyrinth and sculpture by a team including Boston architect Donald Tellalian, that would memorialize the 1915 Armenian genocide. Greenway officials, including conservancy chairman Peter Meade and mayor's task force cochairman Rob Tuchmann, said the process followed by other future occupants of the parks has been violated in this instance. They seek a moratorium on the memorials on the Greenway. (Thomas C. Palmer, Jr.)
